



PUBLIC NOTICE

Based on the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) estimates of the pack and water content at SNOTEL sites, and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's (NOAA) Wyoming Water Supply Outlook the Shoshone and Arapaho Tribes' Wind River Water Resource Control Board has issued a DROUGHT DECLARATION effective March 3rd, 2021 for the entire Wind River Reservation. A Drought Declaration indicates that moisture conditions are below normal and a potential dry period is imminent. All water users should be prepared to implement conservation measures. This notice will be re-evaluated on April 7th, 2021.
